When and how to vote!

Election Day for the Sandpoint city elections is Tuesday, November 3, 2015. Polls will be open from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.

 If you are already registered to vote: Vote at the same polling place as where you vote for all county, state and federal elections. See below



• If you are not yet registered to vote: Any U.S. citizen who is 18 years of age and a resident of the City of Sandpoint for at least 30 days prior to the election can register to vote. The deadline for registering to vote at the polls in advance of Election Day is now closed. However, you may register and vote at your designated polling place on Election Day. In order to register to vote, you must have a photo ID (either a driver's license or State-issued identification card). If the address on the photo ID is not your current address, you must show any document which provides proof of current residence, such as a utility bill in your name.
